

You'll Go Wild for These Animals

We just launched our BRAND-NEW slate of adoptable animals! Every time you buy a wildlife adoption kit, you welcome an adorable new cuddle buddy into your home - we donate the proceeds to conservationists who are working to save real-life animals!

This year, we're proud to support six conservation projects, preserving habitats from the Arctic Circle to the jungles of Costa Rica! Three of our researchers are working in Canada's tundra to save polar bears, caribou, and ringed seals. Another scientist is making space for swift foxes in the prairies, and another is clearing invasive species out of moose, river otter, and Eastern wolf habitat in the Frontenac Arch. Out west, in the Rockies, you can find American badgers and bighorn sheep in our Kootenay Ranch preservation project. And finally, down South, a whole team of researchers is hard at work preserving the Osa Peninsula for jaguars.
