National Textile Diversion Partnership

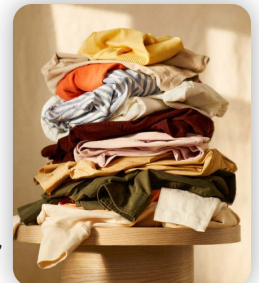
Morguard Properties is proud to partner with Diabetes Canada and York University to tackle textile waste and responsibly divert textiles from landfill, while supporting Canada's first National Textile Diversion Study and the 11.5 million Canadians that are impacted by Diabetes.

Through this innovative partnership, we were able to divert 25,067 pounds (11.37 T) of textiles from landfill in Q1 2023, which is the equivalent of 254 tons of abated carbon, 42 kiloliters of water saved, 11,671 trees planted, and 55 cars removed from the road. This program is currently offered in four of our Morguard shopping centre properties.

Best Practices in Sustainable Retailing

Fashion that Gives - H&M practices sustainable fashion by using recycled clothing to create new garments and offering store credits for old clothes. Their "Conscious" clothing lines consist of at least 50% sustainable materials. This spring several Morguard shopping centres partnered with H&M and launched "Fashion that Gives" a Morguard program encouraging shoppers to donate their pre-loved clothing items for a chance to win shopping centre gift cards.

Subway's Packaging Goals include creating 100% recyclable, compostable, or biodegradable packaging, increasing the use of recycled materials, and collaborating to improve container recycling rates.



The Buzz... Morguard has created "sustainability in action" practices with the objective of implementing or adding to sustainable practices throughout their properties. 7 Morguard properties currently have rooftop beehives in an effort to save the bees! Bees are in serious danger due to wide-spread pesticides, habitat loss and climate change which is affecting their job to pollinate the plants for the food we eat. This is just one of many ways we're actively taking part in sustainable development in our communities!
