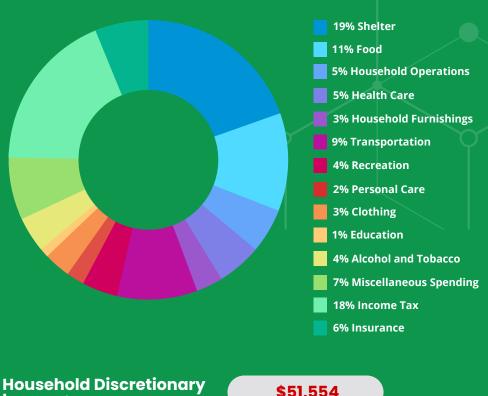


WHERE ARE THEY COMING FROM?

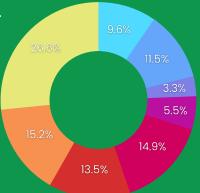
